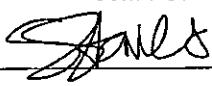

November 14, 2019**

Item No. 1 Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 5:31 p.m. with the following members present: Larry Offerdahl (chair), Bill Fraser, David Downs, and Tim Bennett. Absent: Brian Dale, Nancy Joslin, and Steven Bolen. Collin County staff present: Jeff Durham and Teresa Nelson. Guests: none.

Item No. 2 Approval of September 12, 2019, Minutes

Bill made a motion to approve the minutes, second by Tim, which passed unanimously.

Item No. 3 Update regarding the Project Funding Assistance Program, 1st Series, 2018 Bond (\$2 million)

Jeff gave a brief update of the approval by commissioner's court for the recommended funding. He also reported that approximately six interlocal agreements have been returned for county's execution, which then allows the city's project(s) to commence. Larry asked if any questions were received from the cities why not funded with Jeff responding 'no'.

Item No. 4 Update regarding outstanding projects from the 2007 Bond, Project Funding Assistance Program

Jeff updated the members regarding cities that have projects outstanding that were discussed at the September meeting in which the board approved staff to proceed with rescension. The following is a reminder of what was presented in the previous board meeting: The City of Frisco (Dominion Hike/Bike Trail, 2014); City of Anna (Natural Springs Park, 2016); City of Farmersville (JW Spain Athletic Complex, 2016); City of McKinney (Bonnie Wenk Park, 2016); City of Plano (Cottonwood Creek Trail Extension, 2016). Jeff was able to obtain information from the cities of Anna, McKinney, and Plano that confirmed the projects were approaching completion. In September, discussion ensued and approved recommending to rescind funding for incomplete projects.

Since the board approved rescension of Farmersville and Frisco, Jeff proceeded but was requested by his supervisor to follow-up again with the cities of Farmersville and Frisco. Jeff reported that both cities responded they would immediately proceed with completing the project to avoid rescension. The board members asked Jeff to provide another update at the January meeting.

Item No. 5 Discussion of the email distribution of quarterly progress reports (if any) and discuss the status of funded projects through the Project Funding Assistance Program

The following cities submitted reports: Town of Fairview (Sloan Creek to Fairview Trail Connection), City of Allen (Watters Branch hike/bike Trail), City of Frisco (Dominion Trail), The Nature Conservancy (Parkhill Prairie), City of Plano (Cottonwood Trail Extension South)
