1. Call Meeting to Order

Carson Underwood called the meeting to order at 5:45 PM with the following members present in person: Ron Tykoski, Carson Underwood ('25 chair), Chris Catullo, Dave Cornette, Bill Kibler and David Bell ('25 vice chair); absent: Bill Fraser and Collin County staff present: Tracy Homfeld and Dawn Redwine Guests: None

2. Approval of July 10, 2025 Minutes

David made a motion to approve, second by Dave, which passed unanimously.

3. Review and discuss current projects funded through the Project Assistance Program

A handout of the 25 projects that are currently in "Open" status, and 1 project that "Closed" since last meeting, was given to those in attendance.

4. Discuss and possible action 2023, 2nd Series applications

A total of seven (7) applications were received with a total project cost of \$6,638,303.19 and a total funding request amount of \$3,002,251.59. This series has a total of \$4 million available be for award and an addition \$806,100.06 in contingency that can be used. The board members individually reviewed the application submittals over the last month. The board considered and discussed each submission individually with the following results:

1. **City of Farmersville (South Lake Kayak Launch)** consensus was to fund
2. **City of Frisco (Panther Creek Veloweb Trail)** consensus was to fund
3. **City of Lavon (Community Park Phase 1)** consensus was to fund
4. **City of Lowry Crossing (Adult Fitness Court)** consensus was not to fund
5. **City of Lucas (Central Loop Trail-West Lucas Road)** consensus was to fund
6. **City of McKinney (Rowlett Creek Trail)** consensus was to fund, however staff is to address some questions to the city.
7. **McKinney MUD 1 (Playground Safety Matting)** consensus was to fund
