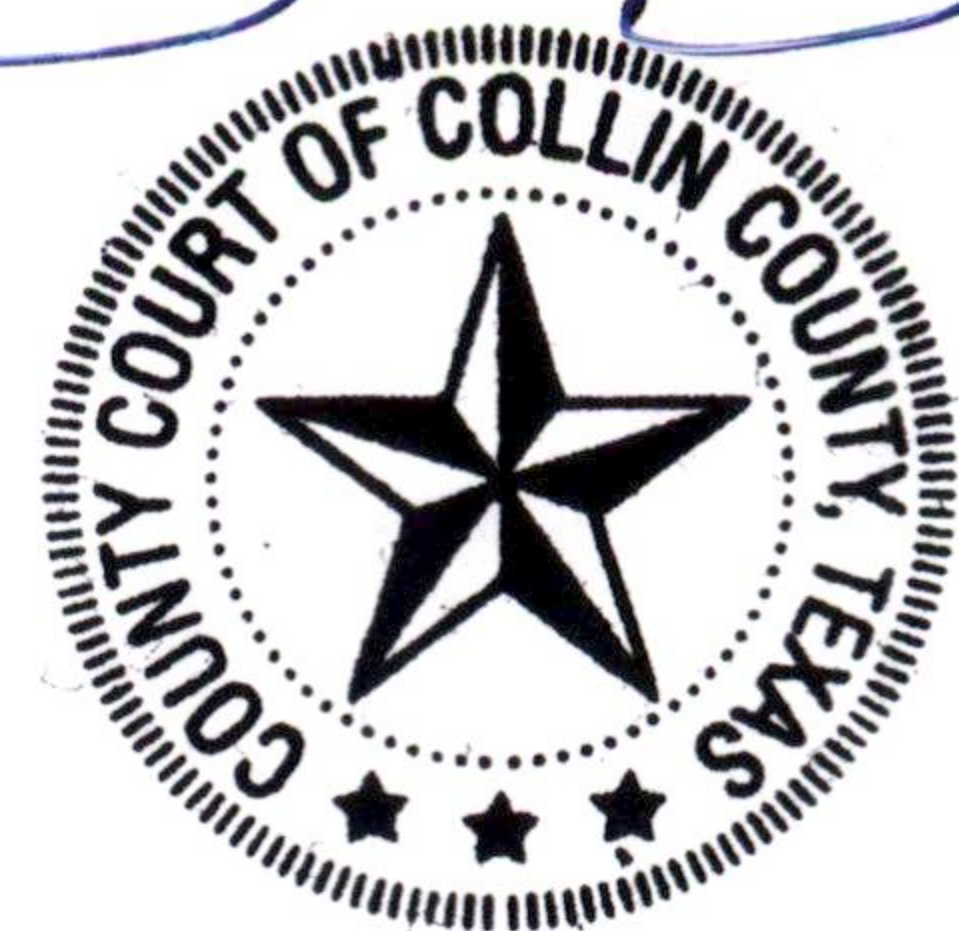

1. Call Meeting to Order

Carson Underwood called the meeting to order at 5:32 PM with the following members present in person: Ron Tykoski, Carson Underwood ('25 chair), Chris Catullo, Dave Cornette, Bill Kibler, Bill Fraser and David Bell ('25 vice chair); absent: None and Collin County staff present: Tracy Homfeld and Dawn Redwine Guests: None

2. Approval of August 8, 2025 Minutes

Dave made a motion to approve, second by David, which passed unanimously.

3. Review and discuss current projects funded through the Project Assistance Program

A handout of the 25 projects that are currently in "Open" status was given to those in attendance. The board requested an update on Project OI18PG29 which is City of Farmersville with the Corp of Engineers. They would also like info on what the Corp plans to do with any parks they will no longer be maintaining. Staff to get this info.

4. Discuss and possible action 2023, 2nd Series applications

A total of eight (8) applications were received with a total project cost of \$7,720,757.94 and a total funding request amount of \$3,843,478.97. This series has a total of \$4 million available be for award and an addition \$806,100.06 in contingency that can be used. The board members individually reviewed the application submittals over the last month. The board considered and discussed each submission individually with the following results:

1. **City of Farmersville (South Lake Kayak Launch)** Dave made a motion to fund the entire request of \$8,407.74, which passed unanimously.
2. **City of Frisco (Panther Creek Veloweb Trail)** David made a motion to fund the entire request of \$1,797,000.00, which passed unanimously.
3. **City of Lavon (Community Park Phase 1)** Dave made a motion to fund the entire request of \$264,946.20, which passed unanimously.
4. **City of Lavon (Community Park Phase 2)** Ron made a motion to fund the entire request of \$541,227.38, which passed unanimously.
5. **City of Lowry Crossing (Adult Fitness Court)** Dave made a motion not to fund, which passes unanimously.
6. **City of Lucas (Central Loop Trail-West Lucas Road)** David made a motion to fund the entire request of \$446,739.15, which passed unanimously.
7. **City of McKinney (Rowlett Creek Trail)** Bill K. made a motion to fund the entire request of \$600,000.00, which passed unanimously.
8. **McKinney MUD 1 (Playground Safety Matting)** David made a motion to fund the entire request of \$115,158.50, which passed unanimously.
