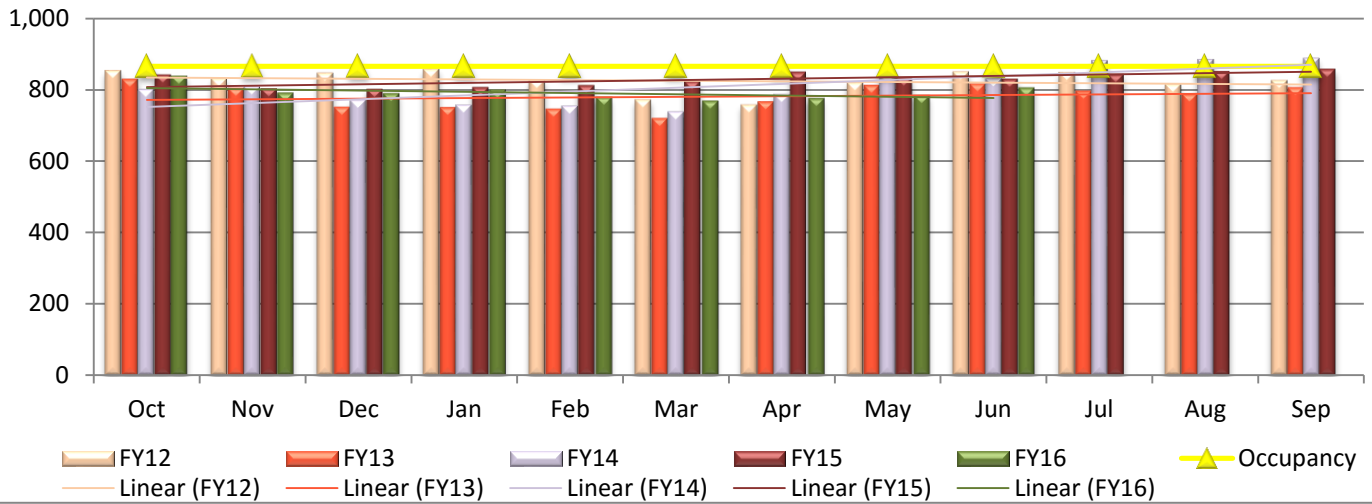

Average Daily Population (Jail)



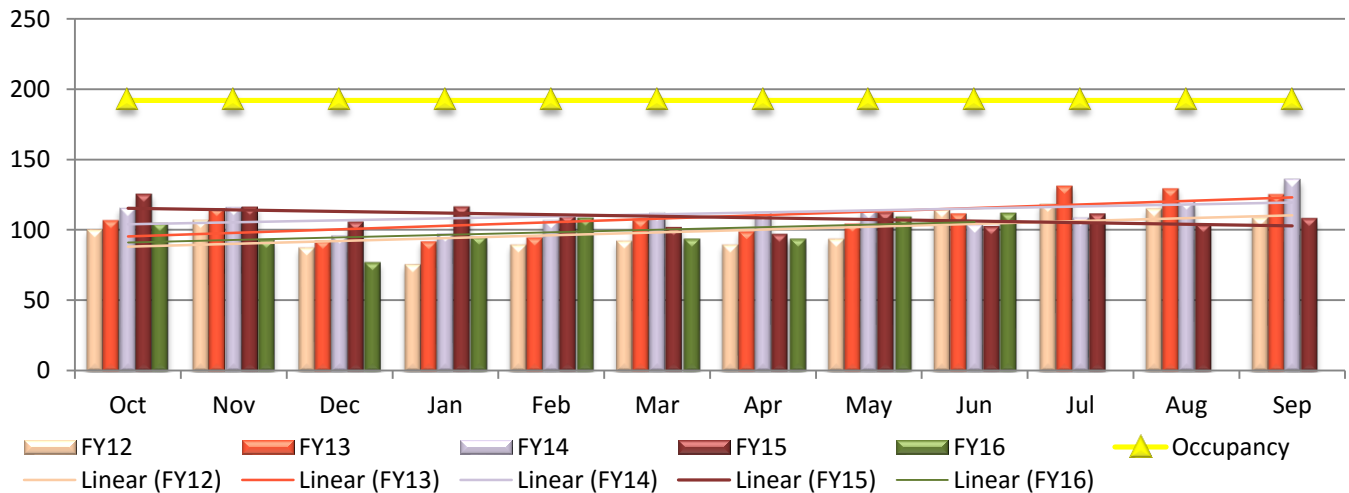

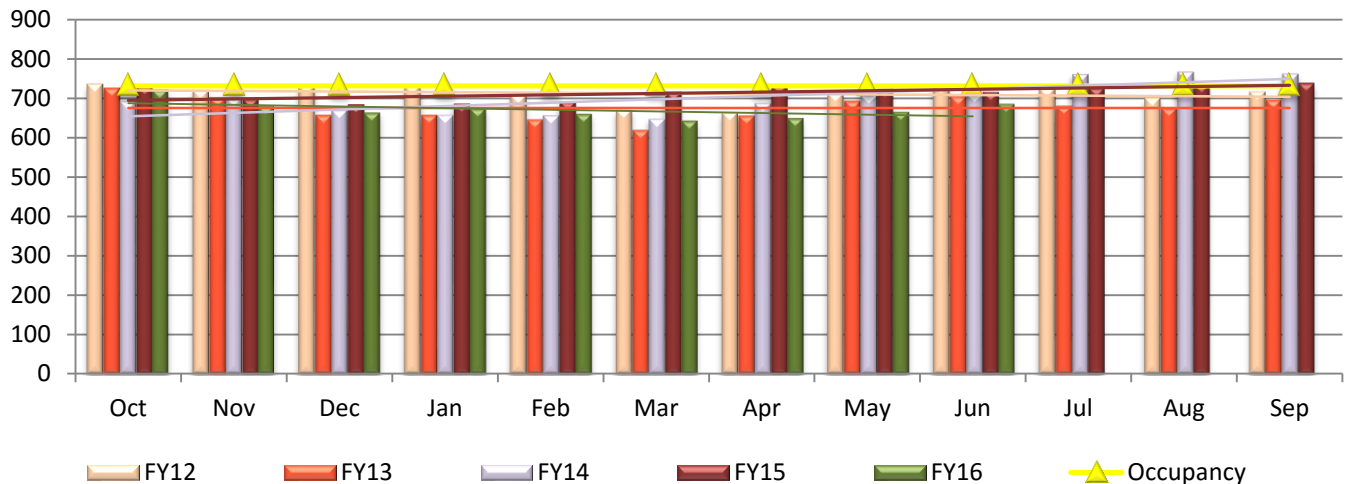

Male Average Daily Population (Jail)



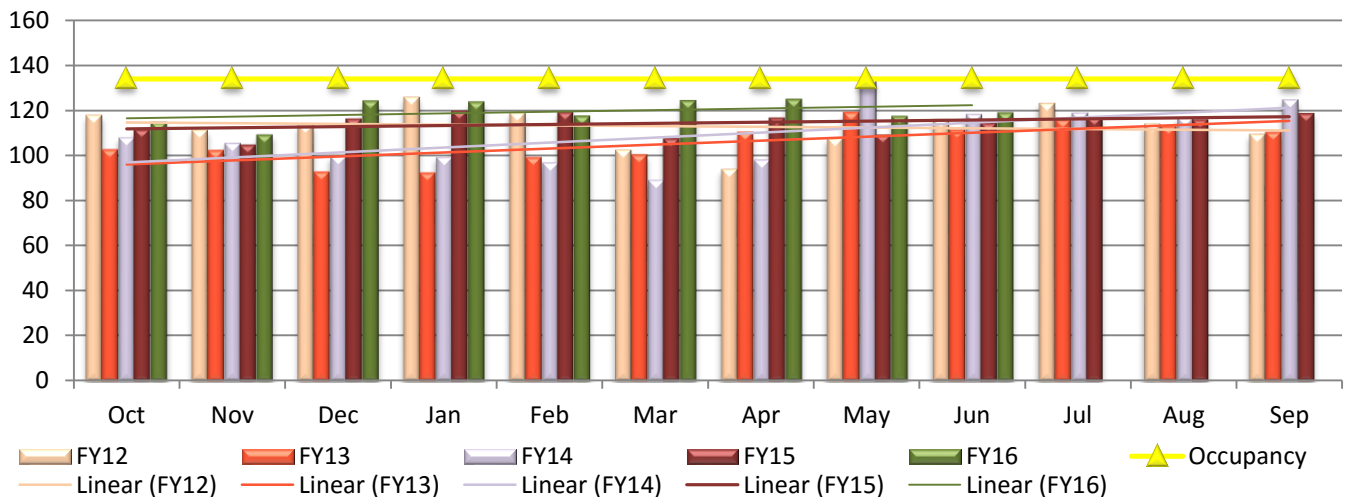

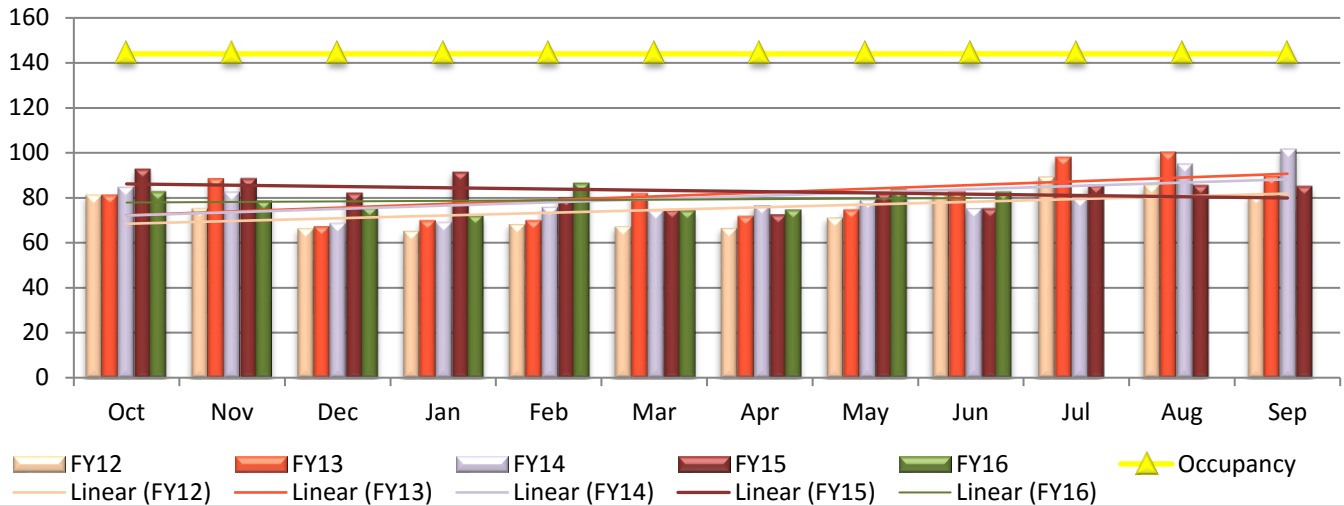

Male Average Daily Population (Min Sec)



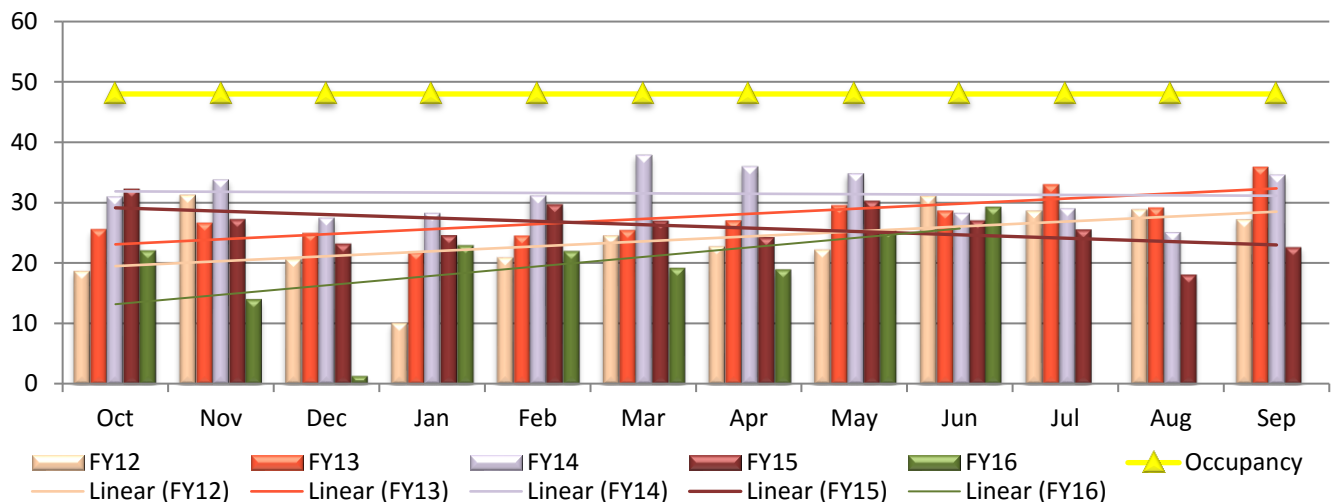

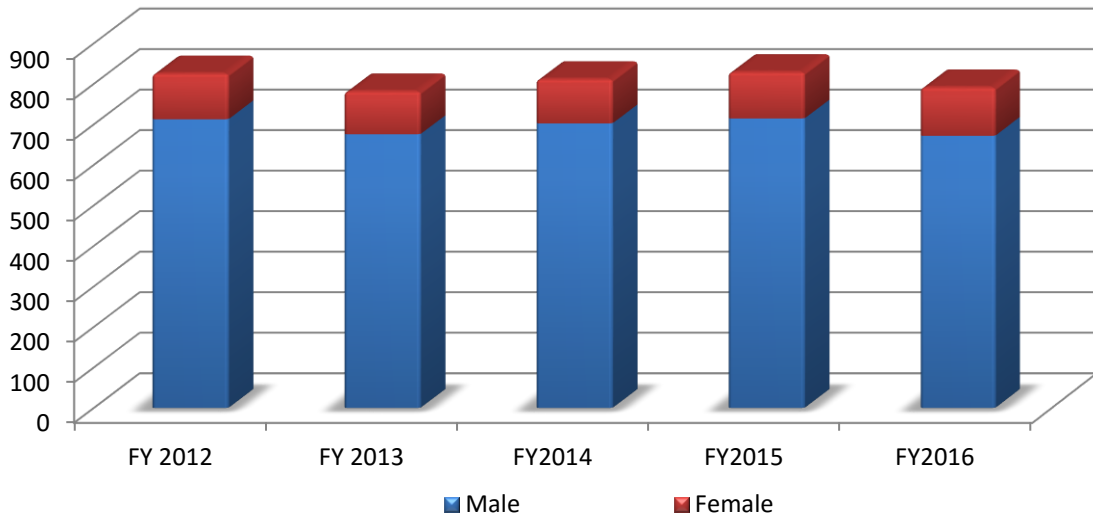

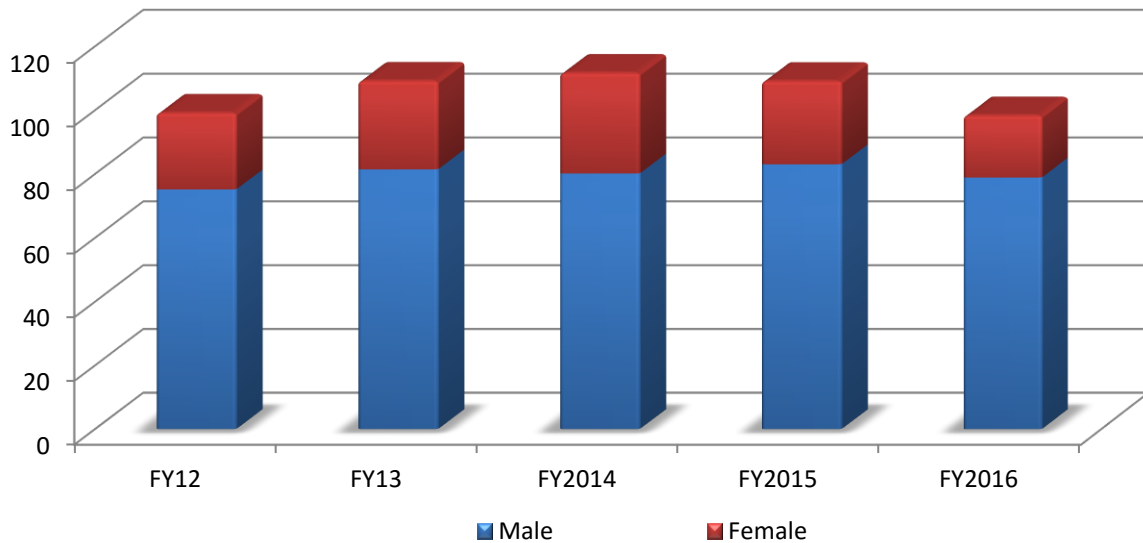
