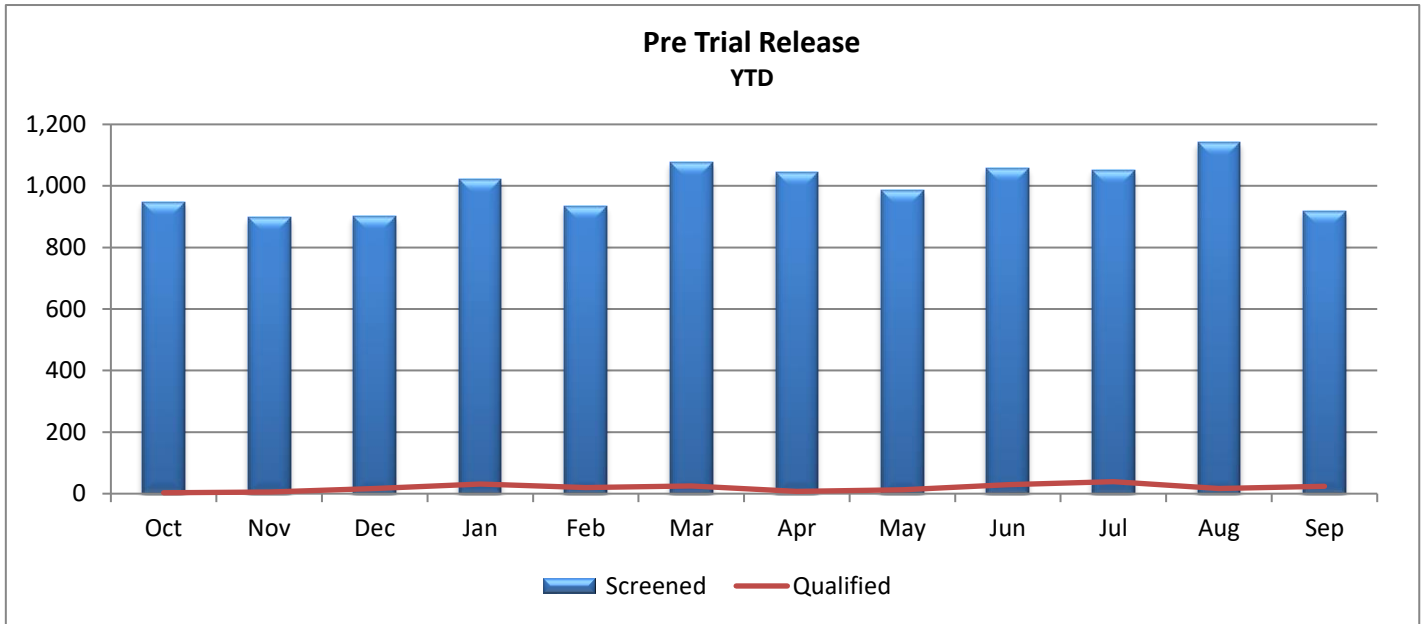
Jail Case Coordinator

This program involves areas pertaining to Community Corrections (work release), monitoring jail populations, designing and recommending methods to reduce jail overcrowding, statistical data reporting in regards to the criminal justice system, coordinating P.I.A. interviews and releases from custody, and other related duties.

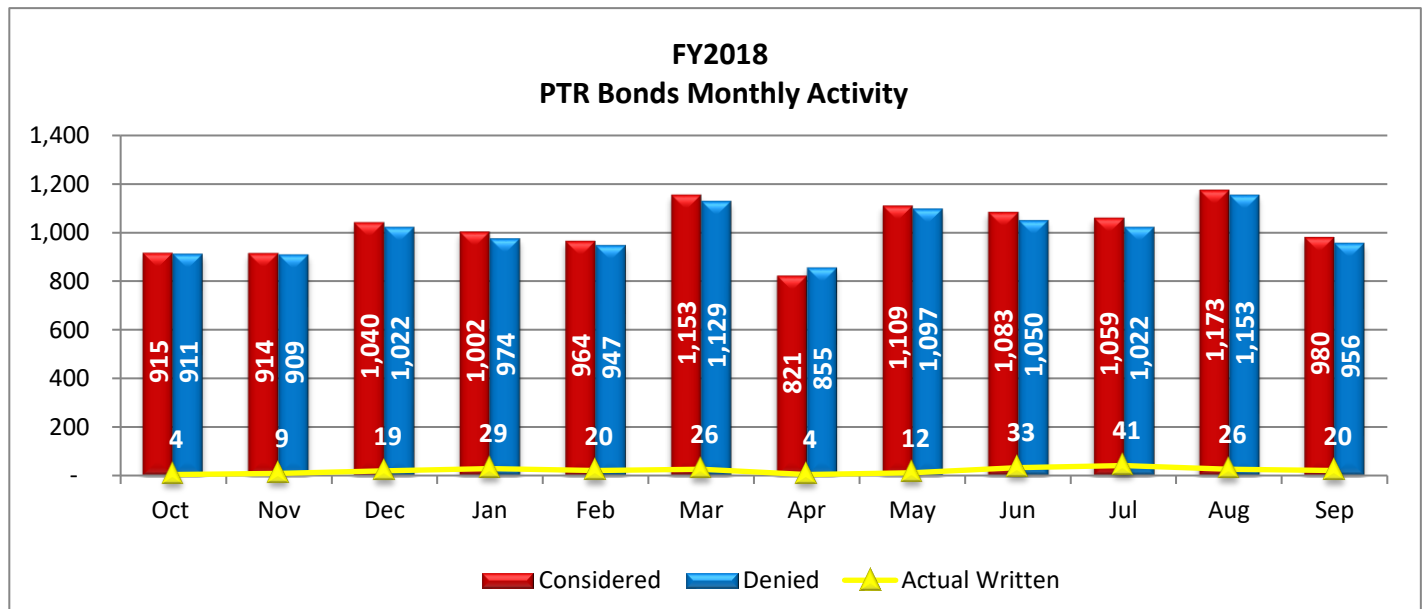
1. To screen 90% of incarcerated individuals and provide Pre Trial Release bonding services to all qualified individuals within 48 hours of their admission to jail
2. To enroll applicable incarcerated individuals to the work release program within 48 hours from their date of sentencing or jail admission date 90% of the time.
3. To ensure all applicable inmates are paper ready and notification made for acceptance by the *Substance Abuse Felony Punishment Facility* w/in 4 weeks of sentencing 90% of the time.
4. To ensure all applicable inmates are paper ready and notification made for acceptance by the *Tx Department of Criminal Justice* w/in 4 weeks of sentencing 90% of the time.

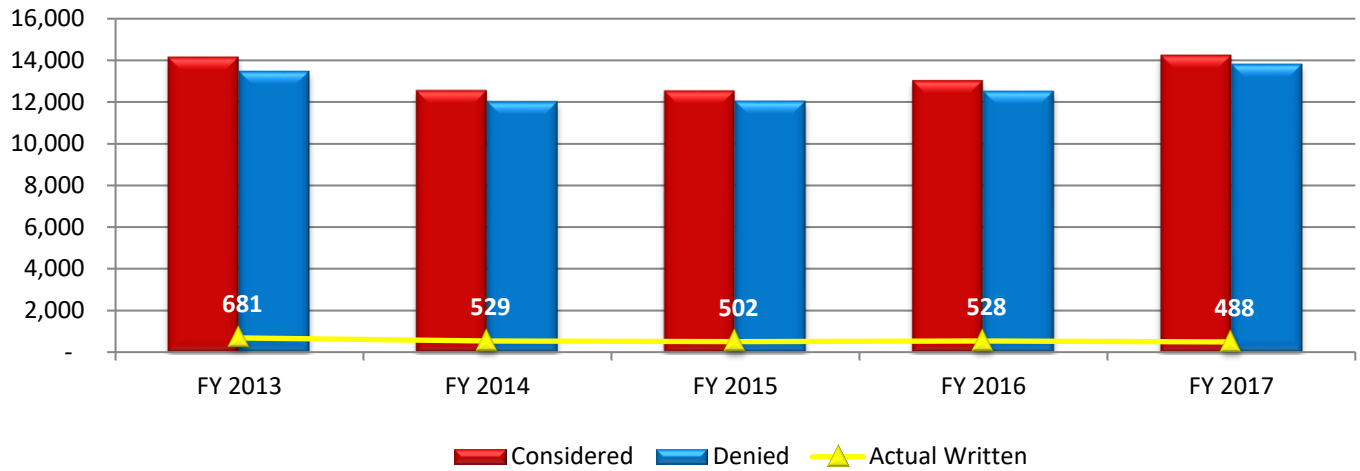
