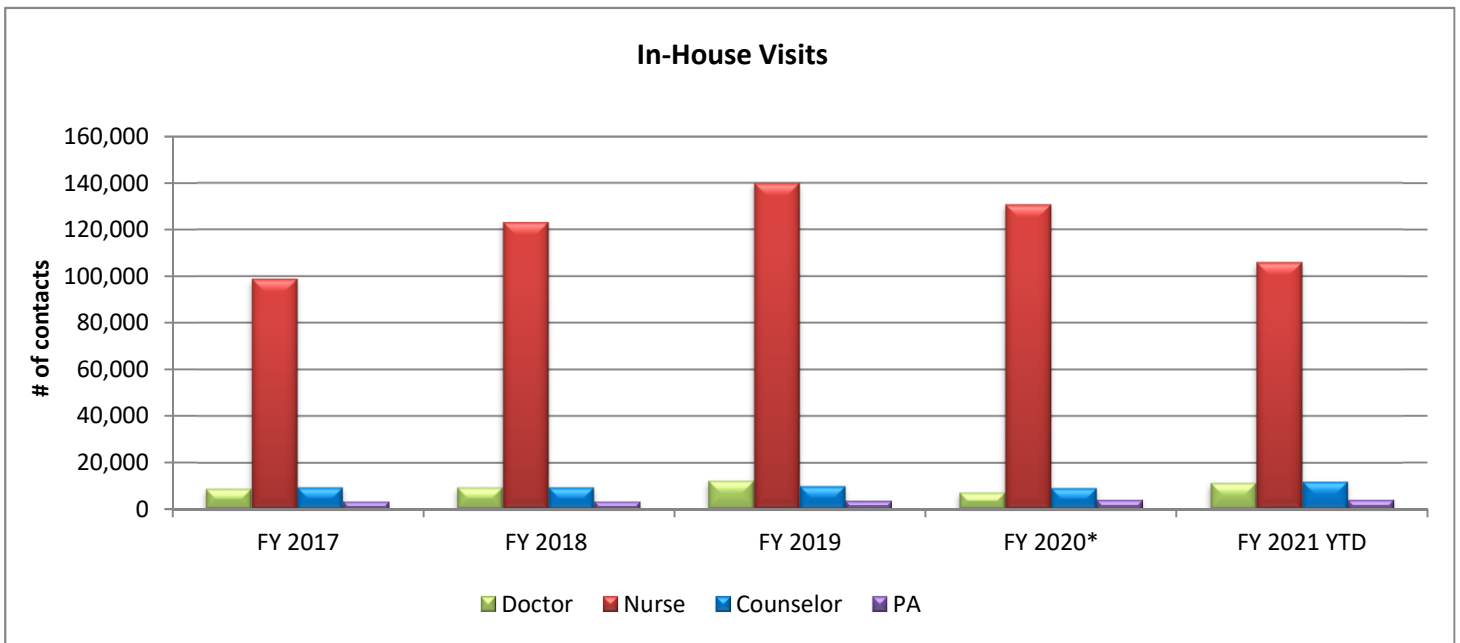
Detention Operations

In addition, federal inmates are housed in this facility by contract with the United States Marshall's Office.

1. To have all inmates seen within 24 hours from sick call placement 90% of the time and remaining request within 48 hours.

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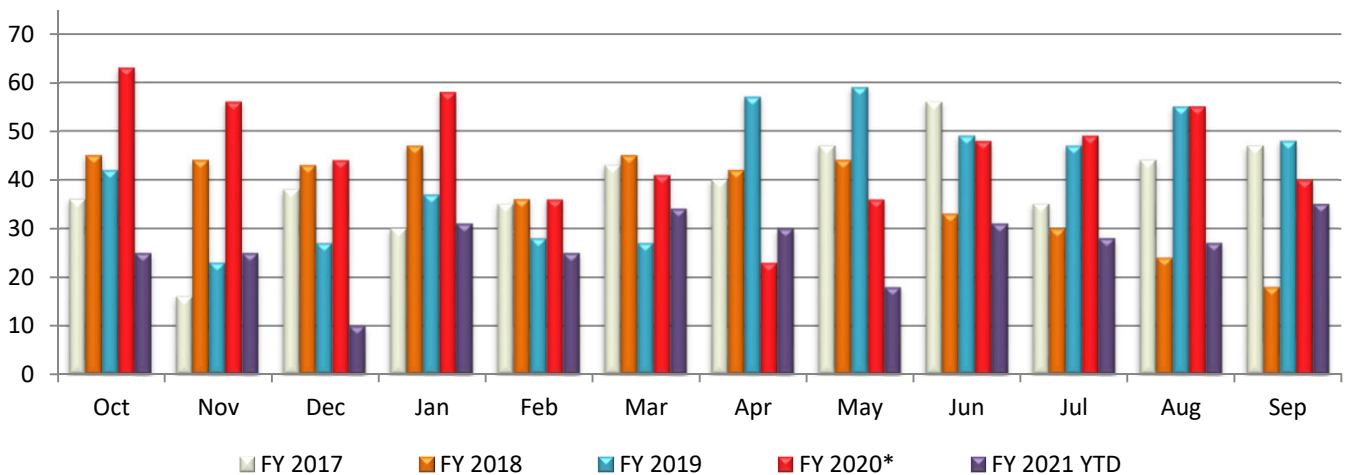

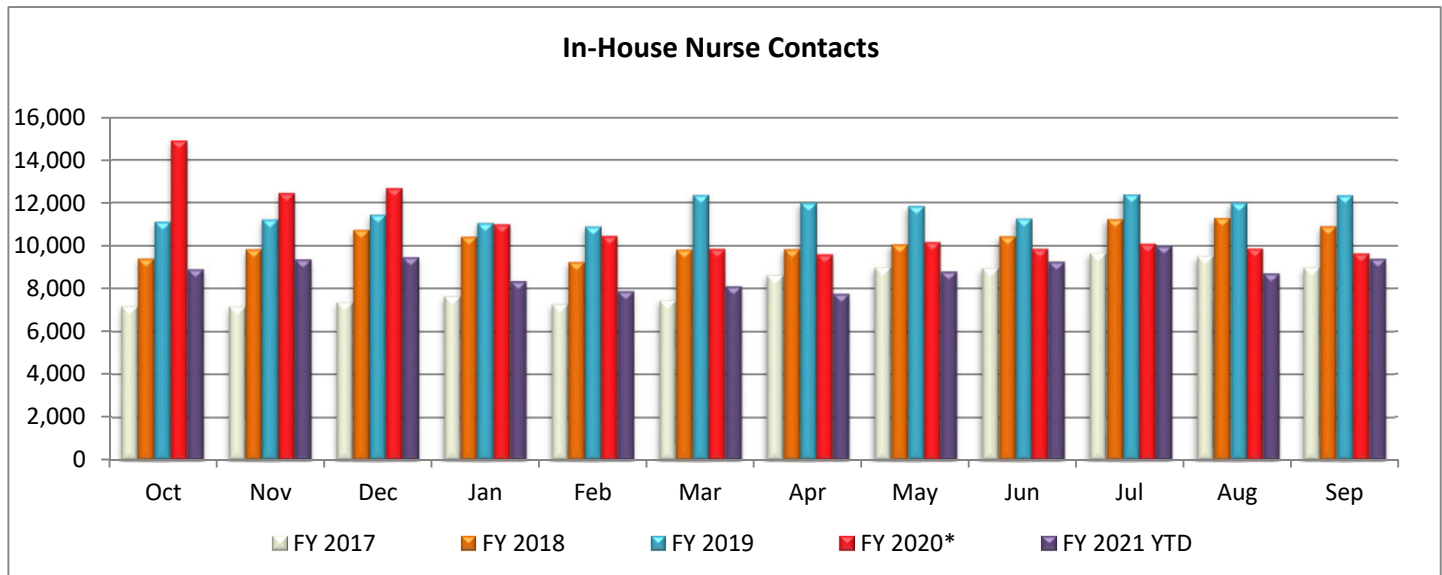

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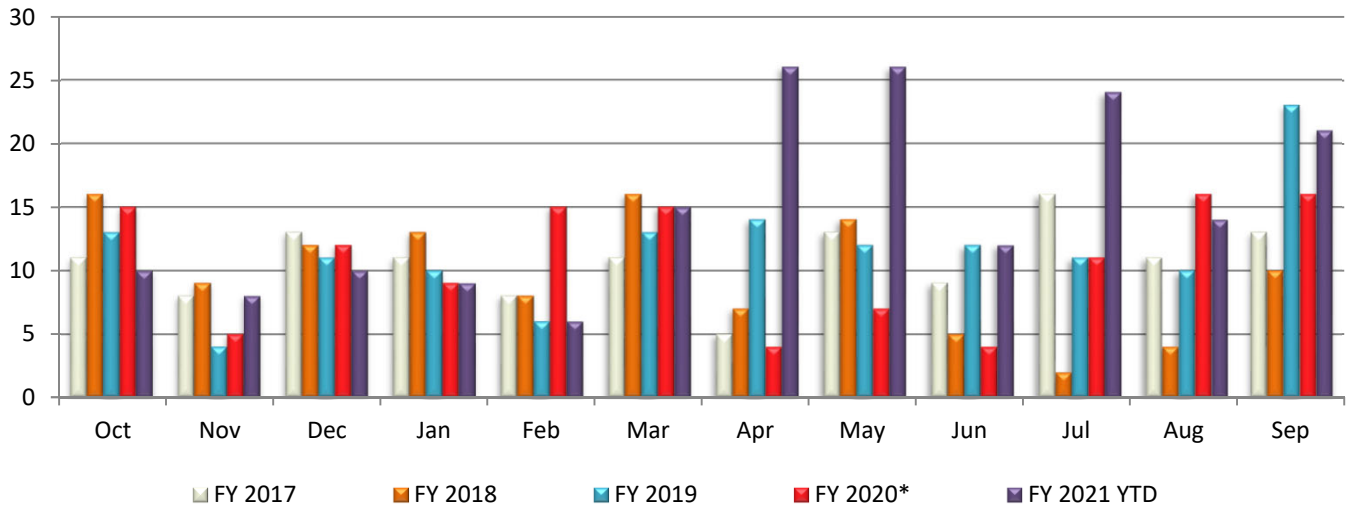

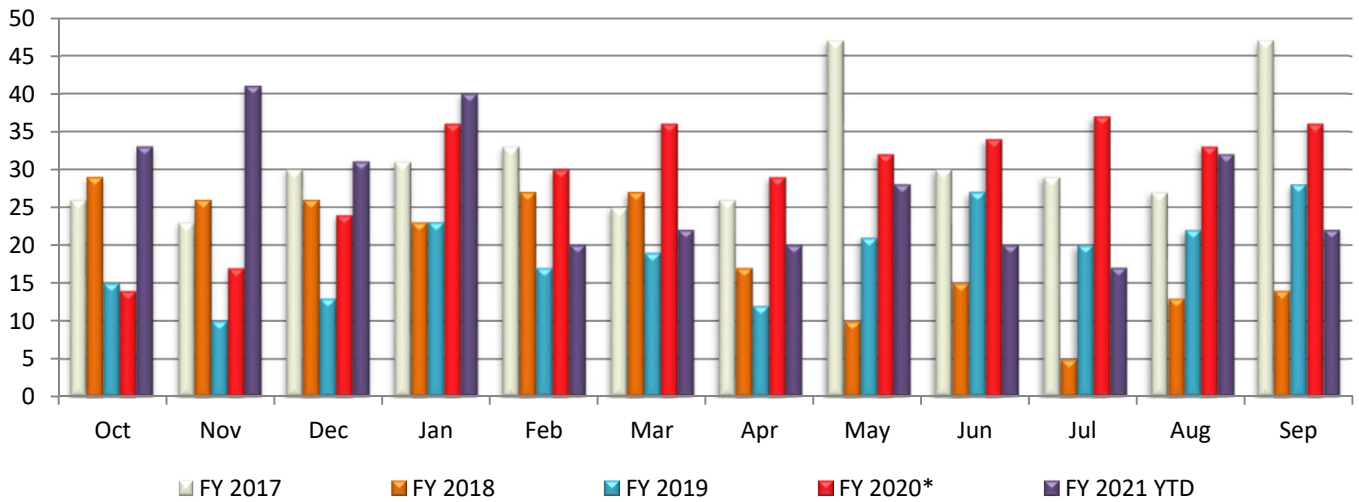

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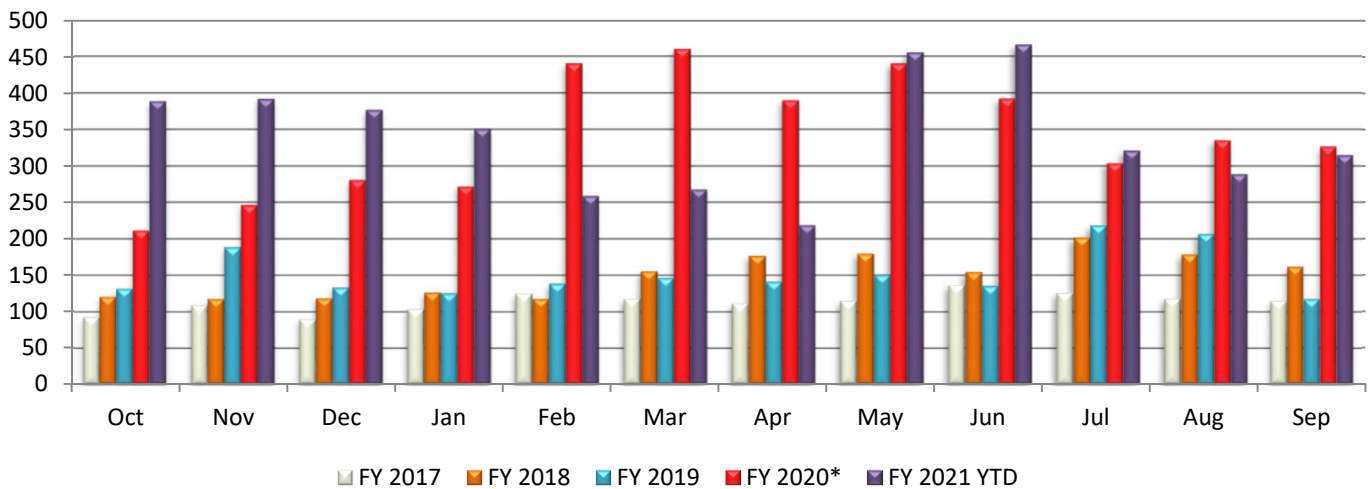
