

ORDINANCE NO. 385

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOWRY CROSSING, TEXAS, CLARIFYING THE ORDINANCE THAT ADDED AN ADDITIONAL WARD AND THAT REDREW WARD BOUNDRIES FOR LOWRY CROSSING CITY COUNCIL ELECTIONS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on June 10, 2025, the City of Lowry Crossing adopted Ordinance No. 384 adding an additional ward and redrawing ward boundaries; and

WHEREAS, a question has arisen regarding the time the positions created by the addition of the new ward can first be filled;

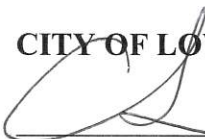
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOWRY CROSSING:

1. Section 5 of Ordinance 384 is amended to read as follows with the underscored sentences showing the added language:

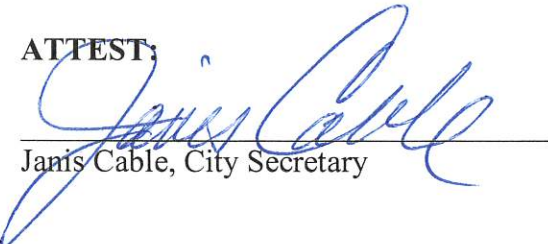
That this Ordinance shall take and be given effect immediately and that thereafter all Lowry Crossing City Council elections shall be held under and in accordance with the new ward districting plan here adopted by the City Council until such time as a subsequent lawfully enacted districting plan shall be adopted to replace this plan. The council positions for Ward 4 will first be filled at the municipal election to be held on November 4, 2025. The existing number of six aldermanic positions will not be affected or increased until the canvass of the election to be held on November 4, 2025.
