#1 The meeting was called to order.

#2 Review of Minutes Reporting

A brief review was given on the reporting of April's board meeting minutes, approved via email and posted prior to the meeting on the CCHCF webpage. Future minutes reporting will follow similar suit.

#3 Samaritan Inn

Heather Molsbee, Chief Program Officer of The Samaritan Inn, gave a presentation on the programs they have to offer and how the funding that Collin County Healthcare Foundation provides is being utilized. They are celebrating their 40th anniversary next year and currently have over 150 residents in their facility. The Samaritan Inn is a transitional housing that has no time limit, but offers support in all aspects of life.

#4 Hope Clinic of McKinney

Andrea Naff, Executive Director of Operations, and Vicki Northcutt, Executive Director of Development, gave a presentation on the services their clinic offer and how the funding that Collin County Healthcare Foundation provides is being utilized. Hope Clinic of McKinney currently has over 1,000 enrolled patients, and expect to continue growing at a rapid rate. This clinic offers free healthcare including, but not limited to, primary care, optometry, and virtual counseling.

#5 General Health Update

Taylor Burton gave a general health update for Collin County. A new RSV (Respiratory Syncytial Virus) vaccine has been developed and will mainly be given to infants and people over the age of 65. As mosquito season is upon us, Malaria and West Nile Virus are being watched for more closely. There has been one case of Malaria in Texas, but Collin County is not at risk at this time.
