#1 The meeting was called to order.

#2 Review of Minutes Reporting

A brief review was given on the reporting of April's board meeting minutes, approved via email and posted prior to the meeting on the CCHC web page. Future minutes reporting will follow similar suit.

#3 Community Health Clinic

Steve Wurm, the Executive Director of the Community Health Clinic (CHC) gave a presentation on the clinic and how they are impacting the community. CHC has been in operation for nearly 19 years and they offer free health care for low income, uninsured, and underinsured individuals in Collin County. The primary focus of CHC is chronic health concerns and reducing poor health outcomes. This clinic has many hospital partners as well as volunteer physicians in the clinic. These volunteers include, but not limited to, Cardiologists, Gastroenterologists, Pediatricians, and Women's Health. The future plans of Community Health Clinic are to expand resources outside of their building and to increase the area that they provide services to.

#4 Health Care Services General Update

Taylor Burton gave an update on COVID-19 current and peak numbers, including positive cases, hospitalization numbers and deaths. The Health Department has recently added a new DIS (Disease Intervention Specialist) program and Taylor gave an update on this program. Monkeypox updates were given concerning total cases, close contacts, and vaccines available in Collin County.
