#1 The meeting was called to order. The minutes from the April 15, 2021 meeting were approved.

#2 PHEP Update

Sophia Vilca Madrid introduced Taylor Burton, Collin County Public Health Emergency Preparedness Coordinator. Ms. Burton gave a presentation on the county's COVID-19 vaccine planning. She reviewed vaccine data for Collin County and surrounding, neighboring counties as well. The data included percentage of population vaccinated, number of DSHS vaccine providers in Collin County, and the COVID-19 vaccine services offered through Collin County. Collin County provides COVID-19 vaccines by appointments, or walk-in at their clinic, mobile vaccinations, and acts as a vaccine distribution hub for Collin County healthcare providers. Ms. Burton highlighted the services provided by the mobile COVID-19 vaccine team. The mobile team travels to residences, long-term care facilities, workplaces, businesses or organizations within Collin County to provide COVID-19 vaccines. Ms. Burton advised that CC Health Care Services has developed preparedness plans for the possibility of future COVID-19 vaccine boosters, including information on vaccine supply, time frame expectations, mobile vaccination team new hires, increases in vaccine storage capacity, and MRC volunteer courier assistance.

#3 Health Care Services General Update

Taylor Burton gave a general update on other areas concerning COVID-19 in our county. Ms. Burton gave an update on COVID-19 case count, contact tracing, occupied hospital bed percentages, vaccination requirements.
