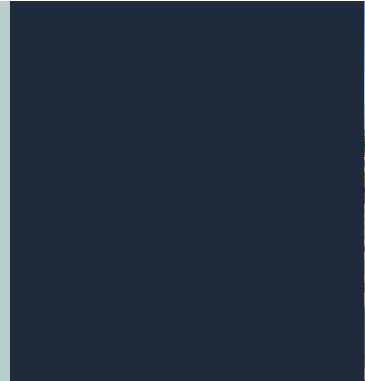
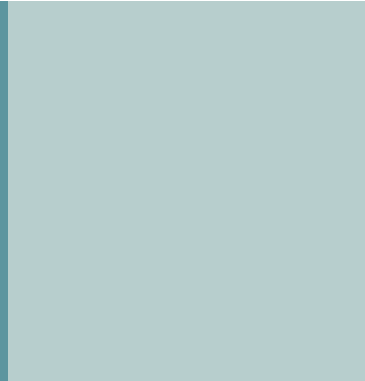




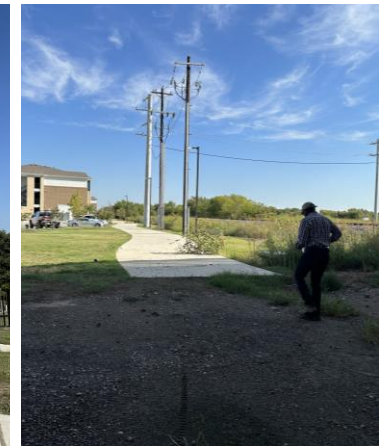

COMMUNITY SURVEY

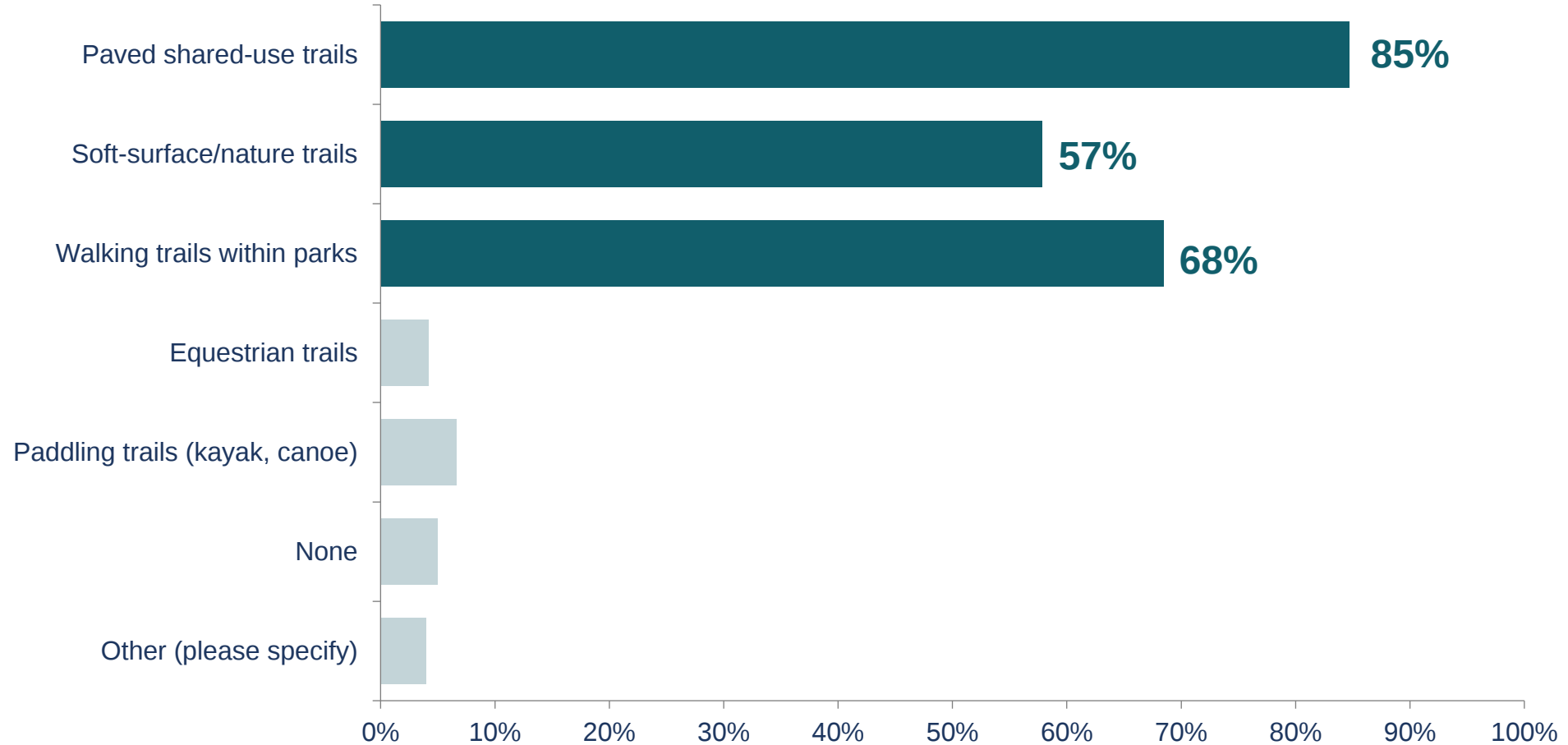
- A Community Survey was available online from **Mid-November to Late December 2024**
- The purpose of the Community Survey was to **obtain initial public feedback** related to Collin County trail usage, existing issues, and future preferences
- The survey received **1,014 responses**
- The findings from the online survey will be used to inform the **master plan recommendations**

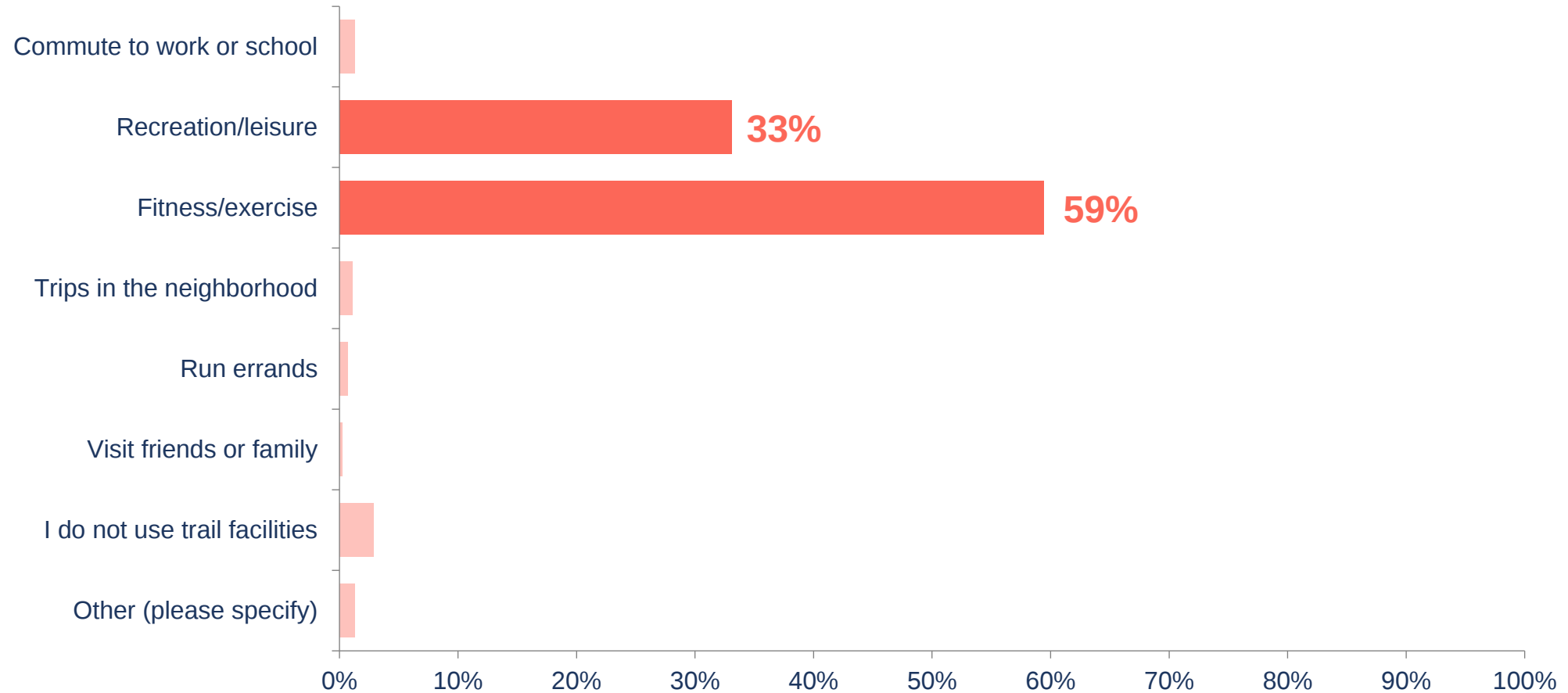

What type of trail facilities do you use in Collin County today?



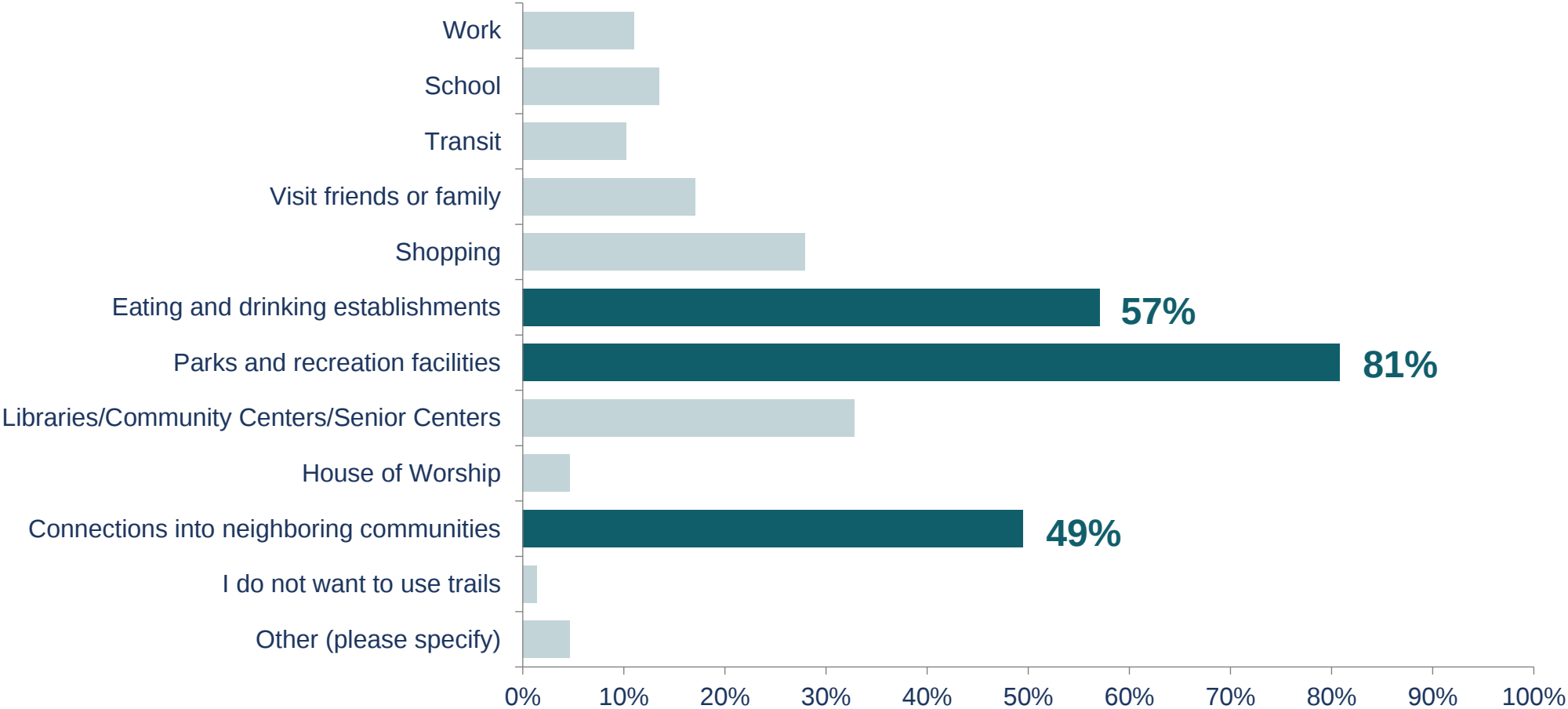

What is your primary purpose for using trails in Collin County?



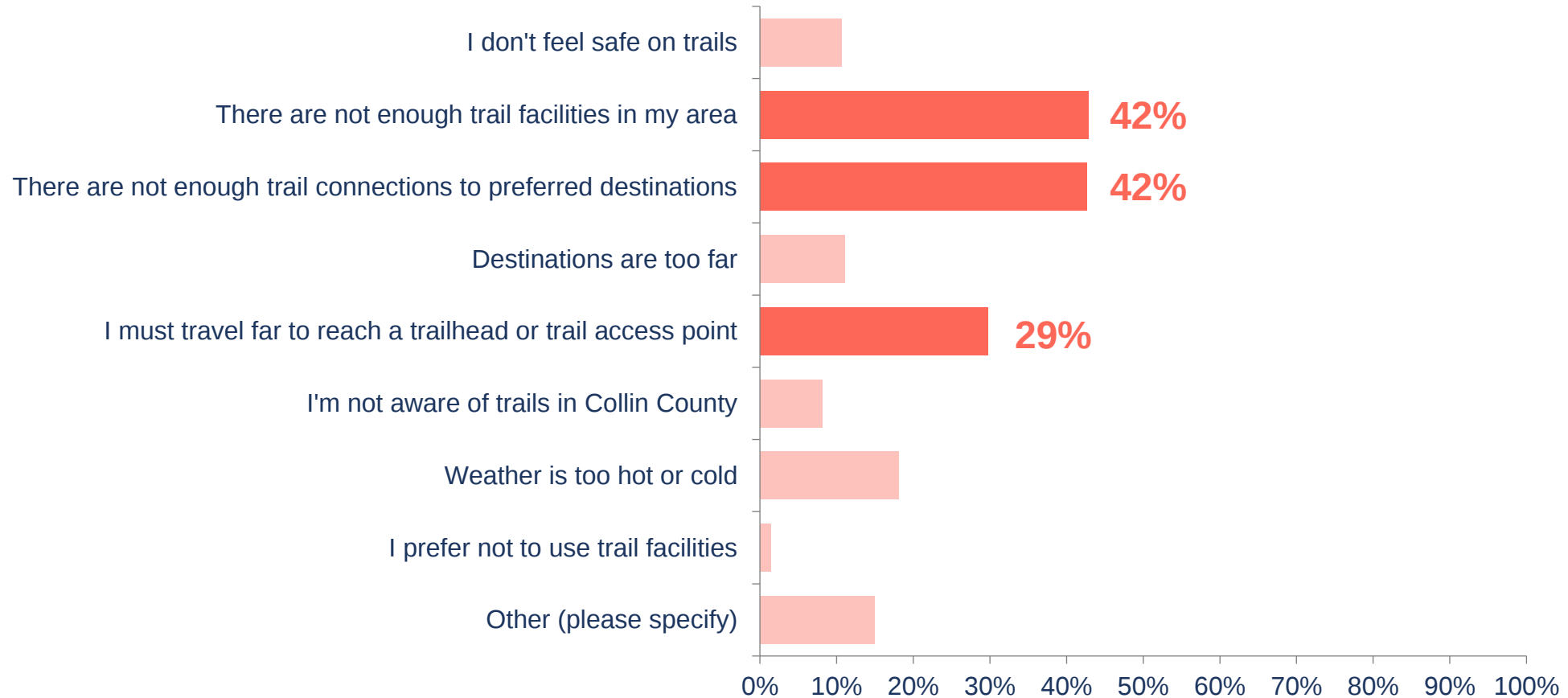

What types of destinations would you like to be able to access by trail?



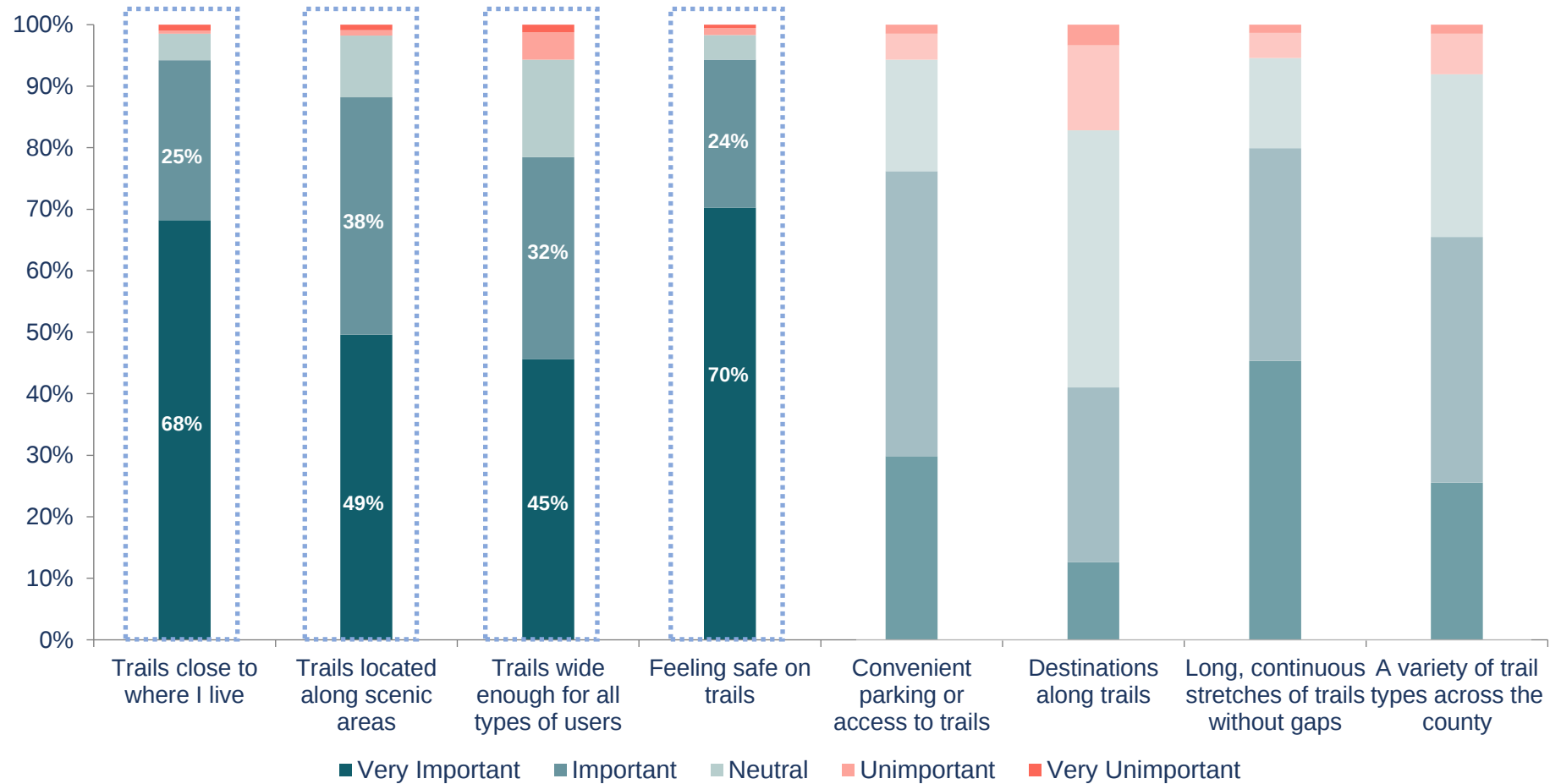

KEY FINDINGS

- The majority of trail users in Collin County today utilize **paved trails** or **walking trails within parks**.
- The primary reason people use trails is for **exercise** or **recreational activity**.
- Trail users would like to be able to use trails to access destinations such as **park and recreation facilities, surrounding communities, and eating and drinking establishments**.
- The main reasons people aren't utilizing trails is because there is a **lack of trails in their area** or **lack of connections to key destinations**.
- Having future trails that are **close to where residents live** is a top priority.
- **Feeling safe** while using trails is a top priority.
