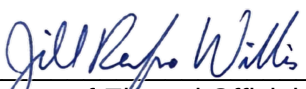

In the past month, Lori has been working with Counsel for our tax cases to develop a new process for scheduling those cases for final trial. This new process will greatly reduce the number of emails and mailings that go back and forth between court staff and Counsel to finalize a setting. It will streamline the process and ensure that all of our tax cases get set timely without placing an unnecessary burden on either side of managing multiple dismissal settings. On February 26, 2025, following a meeting to discuss the implementation of a new process, I received feedback from a law firm who files a high volume of tax cases to express how thankful their office is to work with Lori.
