Why the Honoree is receiving a GEM Award including dates.

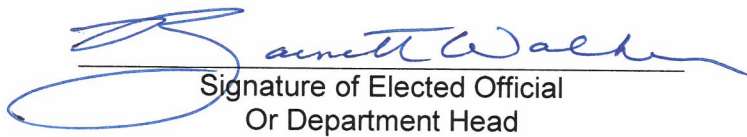
Officer Vest surpasses all expectations on a daily basis. He routinely leads the county in the fewest number of inmates per court. He accomplishes this by checking the jail roster daily and alerting the Court the day an inmate becomes eligible for a personal recognizance bonds, contacting the attorneys to ensure that the cases are proceeding expeditiously, and helping with the inmate plea program on Tuesdays and Thursdays at the courthouse.

Officer Vest arrives at work at least an hour early each day to go through each file of those individuals scheduled to appear in court. He separates all of the individuals that have alcohol related offenses such as Driving Under the Influence, Public Intoxication, or Driving While Intoxicated; then he logs into alcohol monitoring software for SmartStart, Intoxilock, Drager, LifeSafer, Guardian, and Cornerstone Monitoring and looks through all of the daily tests, results, and photos for possible violations. This tedious process has enabled the Court to identify individuals that were having other people (including children) provide breath samples for them. This enables the Court to take immediate action to stop those who are drinking and driving and putting the public at risk.

Officer Vest is a credit to the Sheriff's Office, and this Court.
