He worked vigilantly to make sure no one fell between the cracks and ended up with a warrant and put into the jail. With the ever-changing Supreme Court orders, my court officer has continually set and re-set cases and remailed notice letters to attorneys and defendants. He is constantly reaching out through telephone calls, email and written correspondence to keep defendants out of the jail, but still accountable to the courts.

He helped develop and implemented a new check-in procedure in the courtroom to keep all parties safe while still allowing court business to continue. He is the daily, in person face of Court One even when the court and the rest of the staff work remotely.
