Why the Honoree is receiving a GEM Award including dates:

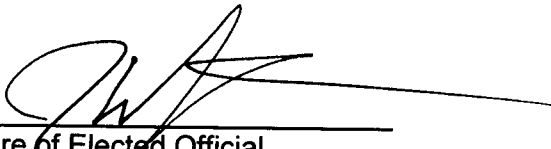
On June 26, 2013 Administrative Secretary Tiffany Eaves assisted a resident of Denton County, at our office, who was having difficulty having a mental health warrant issued and served. Her husband, a retired F.B.I. agent, has a brain tumor and cancer and was becoming increasingly violent, was exhibiting bizarre behavior and had been flashing his F.B.I. badge to others according to Frisco police. The complainant was concerned for not only her safety, but for his and others.

The complainant was directed to our office for assistance, by another police agency, even though she lived just inside of Denton County in Frisco. The distraught complainant was unable to get assistance from the Justice of the Peace and came back to Tiffany for advice. Tiffany took the time to help her by contacting the Denton County Justice of the Peace on her behalf, and reassured her that she could contact her personal cell phone after hours if she encountered additional obstacles.

The following morning, Tiffany worked with the Denton County Justice of the Peace's office to have the warrant delivered to our office since their Constable had no one available. Once received, Collin County Pct. 4 deputies promptly executed the warrant and transported the retired agent to the hospital.

Tiffany is commended for going above and beyond her duties and for showing care, concern and compassion to the citizens we serve. Tiffany's continuous good work and professional representation of this office, is very much appreciated.
