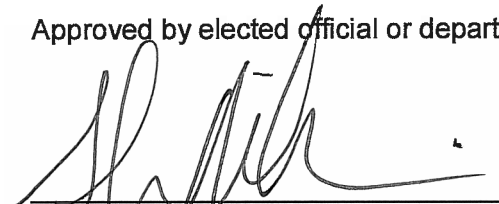

Synopsis:

On November 30, 2016, at approximately 9:40am, Collin County Dispatch advised of an active shooter (that involved the death of the victim) at Hurricane Creek Country Club located in the unincorporated area of Anna, Texas. The suspect was reported to be armed and had fled on foot from the incident scene.

Due to the large unincorporated area surrounding the incident scene, Collin County Sheriff's Office requested assistance with setting up a perimeter.

At approximately 10:00am, due to the severity of the call and the need for additional peace officers, Constable Williams contacted Deputy Kyle Bailey via telephone. Deputy Bailey was scheduled to report for duty at a later time this particular day. Constable Williams explained the incident and requested for Deputy Bailey to respond as soon as possible.

When first arriving in the area, Anna Police Department requested assistance with checking a residence the suspect was known to frequent; Deputy Bailey responded and assisted with this search.

At approximately 10:28am, Deputy Bailey arrived at the incident and was instructed to start patrolling the Hurricane Creek housing addition.

At approximately 10:54am, Deputy Bailey was able to locate the suspect and took him into custody without any further incident.

Deputy Bailey showed his dedication to his duty to protect the citizens of Collin County by responding to the call even though he was off duty when the incident occurred. This commitment continued as he diligently searched for a possible armed gunman that was already known to have murdered someone. Deputy Bailey was able to use his experience and training as a peace officer and took the suspect into custody without further incident to himself, the suspect, or citizens. Deputy Bailey's professionalism presented during an extremely stressful situation is an asset to the Constable's Office, Collin County, and the citizens we serve.
