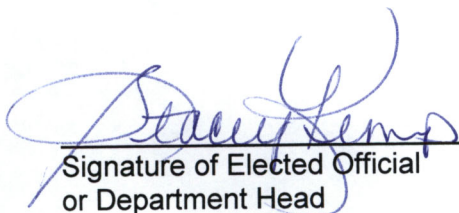

The former Lead Clerk took a position with the Probate Court in May 2016, and while the new manager had previous management experience, she was new to managing the Probate and Mental Commitment departments. Training in the duties of a probate clerk is very tedious and time consuming, however, Dee willingly took on this task with a positive attitude. Because of her attention to the staffs' training, both were able to work virtually unsupervised in less than six months after their employment began and is the "go-to" for any probate related questions. Dee has exceptional knowledge in the statutes that govern the Probate department's duties and responsibilities, and has been extremely helpful in the new manager's transition from co-worker to Probate Administrator.

Dee also created a filing system for Quality Control organization. The system allows for all documents that are processed by the probate court to be organized by day so the documents can be easily accessible during the month.
