
On February 27, 2020, our office secured the death penalty on cop killer Brandon McCall for the capital murder of Richardson Police Officer David Sherrard. Sherrard was the first to arrive at the scene of a murder at an apartment complex. While Sherrard entered the residence actively seeking to help injured civilians, McCall fatally ambushed him with two AR-15 shots from a darkly lit back bedroom.

As lead prosecutor on the case, Bill Wirskeye dedicated months to trial prep, witness interviews and evidence review. He guided the team in their pursuit of justice using his leadership skills and years of capital experience. Bill's efforts assisted in carrying out our mission to pursue justice and protect our community, while also strengthening our bond with our outstanding law enforcement officers.
