

Crissy also singlehandedly organized a procedure for seal in place orders or sealing records without application to comply with the automatic sealing law that went into effect September 1, 2017. As of August 2022, she has processed/sealed 479 cases for these seal in place orders. This project was a huge undertaking and benefits not only our division, but also juvenile probation, the records department and the District Clerks who all have a role in this process. In addition to the sealing project, Crissy continues to streamline our juvenile processes as we continue with the paperless transition; she communicates frequently with the juvenile probation department as more tasks are paperless to ensure nothing is missed and deadlines are met.
