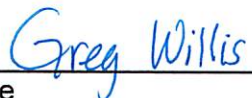
On February 27, 2020, our office secured the death penalty on cop killer Brandon McCall for the capital murder of Richardson Police Officer David Sherrard. Sherrard was the first to arrive at the scene of a murder at an apartment complex. While Sherrard entered the residence actively seeking to help injured civilians, McCall fatally ambushed him with two AR-15 shots from a darkly lit back bedroom.

As a valued member of the team, Laurie Gibbs spent numerous hours locating, interviewing, and securing witnesses for trial as well as gathering and reviewing hundreds of pieces of evidence that were pertinent to the prosecution. Laurie's efforts assisted in carrying out our mission to pursue justice and protect our community, while also strengthening bonds with our outstanding law enforcement officers.
