On February 27, 2020, our office secured the death penalty on cop killer Brandon McCall for the capital murder of Richardson Police Officer David Sherrard. Sherrard was the first to arrive at the scene of a murder at an apartment complex. While Sherrard entered the residence actively seeking to help injured civilians, McCall fatally ambushed him with two AR-15 shots from a darkly lit back bedroom.

As a valued member of the team, Linda Herrera provided assistance in reviewing and gathering evidence important to the trial and was readily available to the lead investigator on the case. Linda's efforts assisted in carrying out our mission to pursue justice and protect our community, while also strengthening the bonds with our outstanding law enforcement officers.
