Nancy coordinated and streamlined our filing system for all emergency removals as well as petitions, motions and orders submitted for our weekly CPS dockets in 6 CPS-designated District Courts. In addition, Nancy created a system for digitally saving and organizing our documents and records on CPS cases, thus stream-lining the dissemination process for our exhibits in the multiple Zoom TBCs held during the pandemic. Nancy's diligent work and efforts benefits not only our division, but also the Judges, Court Coordinators, District Clerks, Attorneys, CASAs and CPS workers with whom we routinely work.
