On February 27, 2020, our office secured the death penalty on cop killer Brandon McCall for the capital murder of Richardson Police Officer David Sherrard. Sherrard was the first to arrive at the scene of a murder at an apartment complex. While Sherrard entered the residence actively seeking to help injured civilians, McCall fatally ambushed him with two AR-15 shots from a darkly lit back bedroom.

Stacey Taylor invested numerous hours providing emotional and moral support to the many surviving loved ones (two capital murder victims) before, during, and after the trial. Stacey remained consistent and dedicated to the victims by making their needs a priority.
