On the evening of August 6 Matt was monitoring jail phone calls as a follow up to an investigation he was working. In this process Matt heard what he believed an inmate who could possibly be a danger to himself. By cross referencing another inmate's phone information Matt was able to make a positive identification. He immediately reported what he heard to jail staff who were able to reassign the inmate to the infirmary who placed the inmate on suicide watch and provided mental health professionals that could intervene.

Matt's quick actions prevented the inmate from causing harm to himself. It is his attention to detail that led to the resolution of this situation.

Matt also received a letter of commendation from Sheriff Skinner for his actions.
