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Last year, Holly moved to a new position in the department, taking on new duties and responsibilities.

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One of her new responsibilities is the maintenance, update, and audit of the fixed asset system, which includes accounting for all capital purchases, disposals, and movement of assets.

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With a due date of March 31, 2013, and over the course of several months, Holly worked diligently to find, identify, and reconcile the purchases of capital assets, including a number of prior year purchases not entered in the system by the prior person handling the work.

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Holly's hard work and determination to "straighten out the records" culminated with the external auditor review (part of our annual financial reporting) and no findings or errors in the work she performed. The total value of County assets is almost \$675 million.

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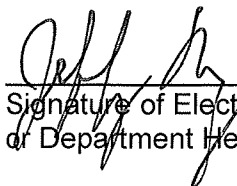
The work on this project had been in progress for more than four years when Holly took it over; starting from scratch, she completed the work in a matter of months.
