She looked into the Laserfiche recycle bin and the document was there. She was not sure if they had meant to delete the document when they moved it into Laserfiche or if it was an accident. She got with the department and it was found to have been an accidental delete and it was restored and moved to the file. Without this being caught, this information would never have been added to the original record. This was an exceptional catch on Paula's part and it led to us working with the department on best scanning practices to help alleviate potential future errors such as this.
