Why the Honoree is receiving a GEM Award including dates:

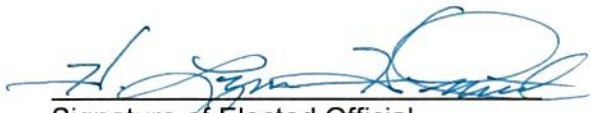
On October 7, 2016, Anne made an afterhours visit to the juvenile detention center to deliver her staff some food for their enjoyment. Anne was not schedule to be at work at
