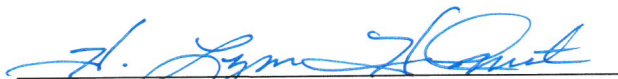

He also agreed to go through and discard older books in the current rotation and other books residents were uninterested in or were worn/damaged. After reviewing these books, he updated the full scope of books in our library and lab. This was not an easy task considering we had not updated either the library or lab in several years. Books deemed inappropriate or cycled out were reallocated to a local book store and we were given credit to purchase newer books. Pat has reviewed over 1,000 books, carted books off to different locations, cleaned book shelves, updated, discarded, reallocated, met with Administration and a school staff on feedback, and agreed to continue reviewing all incoming books- moving forward. As an avid reader, Pat spent several weeks going through books in order to peak the interest of our residents to read more.
