Officer Roy Storey always goes above and beyond to assist officers in the secure environment.

He was recently contacted on a Sunday afternoon and was called in on his day off to transport a juvenile to the emergency room, and agreed with no notice to come in to assist others.

Officer Storey came in during shift change, and escorted a juvenile to the emergency room. Officer Storey took a new officer with him, to train the new officer on transports outside the facility. Officer Storey maintained communication with the guardian, who was not allowed to accompany the child to the hospital during the emergency room visit. He maintained communication with the detention facility, and the facility administration, ensuring that the child's medical needs were met, but also reassuring the guardian that the child was being well cared for.

Officer Storey has volunteered to work overtime, including evenings and weekends when needed during the COVID-19 pandemic. His readiness to assist shift supervisors during this time has provided vital coverage in the pods when needed.
