On February 7th, 2017 the report, which limits locations and jailing flags to show only the potentially suicidal inmates in the jail's general population, was completed and introduced to detention staff. Through the efforts of Matthew Dyer and Douglas Hall, the liability incurred in a potential lapse of Texas Jail Standards by missing a special watch was further limited at no extra cost to the citizens of Collin County. It is for this reason that we would like to recognize Detention Officer Matthew Dyer for going above and beyond the scope of his duties to provide the citizens of Collin County with a safer and more proactive Detention Center.
