(2) As a Bonds Officer, Officer Garcia covers for Officer Burnett when she is out of the office. Officer Garcia reviews bonds from the day before, corrects bonds if needed, sends bonds to their appropriate locations, and ensures all monies are accounted for in a timely manner. (3) As an Arraignment Officer, Officer Garcia's knowledge with the duties required of this position are impressive. Officer Garcia has gained the respect of several magistrates due to his quick and accurate responses to requested information. Officer Garcia is a true team player.
