Why the Honoree is receiving a GEM Award including dates:

On June 3, 2019, the Collin County Detention Facility had a fire on the roof of the building.

Detention Officer Anissa Marshall was assigned to Building Control Room. She received the initial phone call raising the fire alarm at the same time of radio request for assistance on an inmate disturbance. She simultaneously managed both situations via radio, telephone and video surveillance. She summoned officers to the scene of the fire and called 911 to request assistance from the fire department all while operating the facility doors to allow officers responding to both events.

Due to Ofc. Marshall's ability to multi-task and manage the situation, a tragedy was averted and the fire did not spread to the other areas of the facility.

I recommend Ofc. Marshall receive a GEM for her actions during this incident.
