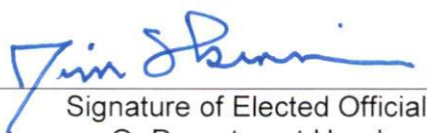
Why the Honoree is receiving a GEM Award including dates:
