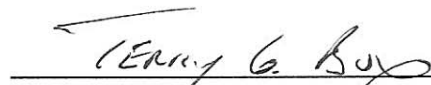

This call took the full attention of one Dispatcher, leaving the other two Dispatchers on duty to handle the remainder of the calls until the end of their shift. Call volume during the dayshift requires a minimum of three Dispatchers.

Bonnie Bowers worked as the call taker during this shift and assisted the Dispatcher involved in the pursuit call, along with handling another 40 calls for services for other Police / Fire Department and Support Personnel.

Together with Dispatcher Jamie McCarty, they were able to handle the 911 calls, Police/Fire dispatching and TLETs duties for their shift. This took a considerable amount of organization, time management, and skill. Because of Bonnie's experience and dedication all calls were handled without incident.
