On 07/08/2021 at approximately 2:40am Deputy Bacon was patrolling County Road 469, in unincorporated Collin County when he noticed a suspicious vehicle in an area that is not usually there. Deputy Bacon made contact with the driver of the suspicious vehicle who stated that he was in the area to pick up a trailer a friend had told him about.

Deputy Bacon utilizing the application of intelligence-led policing by a deputy who is not only familiar with his patrol beat but also the persons within knew the owner of the trailer. After contacting the owner of the trailer Deputy Bacon was able to verify that owner of the trailer did not give anyone permission to take the trailer. The suspect of the attempted theft of the trailer was issued a criminal trespass warning and released from the scene.

Based on Deputy Bacons keen awareness and knowing his patrol district and the persons within I believe he prevented a trailer theft from occurring.
