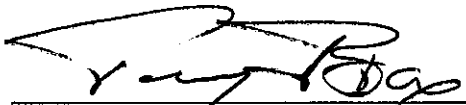

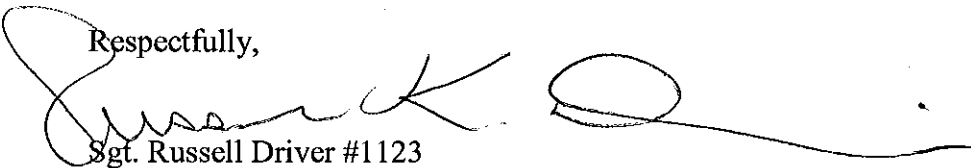
I would like to commend Deputy Brian Borton for his part in solving Theft of Copper offense committed on September 12, 2011.
