Lieutenant Fichtl,

I would like to nominate Deputies Stasik and Sibley for a GEM award for actions taken while on a Burglary call in Westminster. Deputy Stasik was dispatched to a burglary of a habitation after the owner arrived home to find his home had been broken into and items were stolen. Stasik received permission to contact Crime Scene and have them respond to the scene in order to obtain any possible evidence. While waiting for crime scene, Deputy Stasik began actually investigating the incident rather than just sitting in his vehicle and doing the offense report, he put forth extra effort. Deputy Sibley arrived to assist him and the two began speaking with neighbors, investigating the scene and actually developed several leads. By the time that Sgt. Jumper, the crime scene investigator on call arrived to process the scene, the deputies had three suspects in custody and had recovered all of the victim's belongings including several firearms.

The deputies were not required to conduct any type of investigation other than preliminary in order to obtain basic facts of the case for criminal investigators. However, both deputies took it upon themselves to do more in order to assist the victim and recover his stolen property. The incident was handled professionally and resulted in three felony arrests. I would also like to point out that their actions were noticed by numerous citizens of the county resulting in them representing our agency in a positive manner.
