On June 13, 2012, he was contacted by a Detective with Plano P.D. in reference to an inmate that was out on court ordered GPS monitoring as a condition of bond. Deputy Spears was asked if there was a way to check the whereabouts of the inmate during a certain date range. Deputy Spears did hours of backtracking the inmate's whereabouts which allowed Plano P.D. to link him to three open burglary cases.

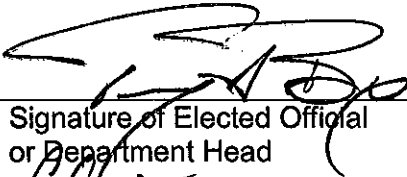
Deputy Spears was also contacted by McKinney P.D. for the same information and linked the same person to two open burglary cases in McKinney.

Deputy Spears is currently assisting Dallas County Sheriff's Office accordingly.

The inmate is currently in jail and five burglary charges have resulted from Deputy Spears' efforts. This type of assistance improves working relationships with

surrounding agencies and Deputy Spears is to be commended for his work on these cases.
