Why the Honoree is receiving a GEM Award including dates:

On March 6, 2018, Princeton Police Department asked Investigator Meehan to assist with a school threat. A school official received an email on March 6, 2018, stating that "Gabe" posted a photo on snap-chat with a gun telling people to avoid school on Monday. The student that sent the email was unknown person warning the school.

The school questioned some students, but got nowhere. Investigator Meehan researched the email that was sent to the school, and obtained a search warrant for Google to provide him with information related to the account.

Investigator Meehan was able to locate a phone number that showed to belong to a residence in Princeton, and a student that lives there attends Princeton HS. They questioned that student, and the student confirmed that she sent the email to the school attempting to warn the school.

Upon further investigation, they identified the 16 year-old suspect. The suspect admitted to the threats and they placed him under arrest for Terroristic Threat. Investigator Meehan's role was a huge factor in the investigation.
