On August 21, 2018 the Collin County Sheriff's Office Admissions/Release division underwent a full conversion of the Texas Commission on Jail Standards Screening Form for Suicide and Medical/Mental/Developmental Impairments intake screening process, from the previously unfunded State mandated manual paper process, to a fully electronic Laserfiche business flow process. Lieutenant Gann conceived the idea for this process in 2016, and initiated it by contacting Collin County Information Technologies. He spent many months in preparation for this project, meeting with I.T. personnel and working to develop the initial screening form and business flow process, until his transfer to the Detention Housing division. Lieutenant Gann's expertise in Admissions/Release and the intake screening process, along with his forward-thinking attitude, was central to ensuring the success of a process that is now fully functional, saving the Admissions/Release division countless hours of manual paper processing and increasing staff productivity and process efficiency.
