Chuck was faced with a backlog of more than 1,100 expungement orders and no process in place to handle such a task. After applying a logical business practice solution to software, he worked with various departments and the District Clerks office to establish a work flow. As he worked this new process, the number of backlog orders fell to 376.

Chuck has done this while continuing to maintain his participation in the SoftCode project, his participation in the Odyssey Control Board, system security, and addressing the various issues that come up in Odyssey software.

While there is still more work to do, this has been a tremendous success for the Sheriff's Office.
