Re: GEM and Employee of the Month Recognition

In November of 2021 the Sheriff's Office responded to an armed home invasion in Lucas, Texas. The case, with virtually no viable leads, was assigned to Sgt. Jay Reim. Through the course of his investigation Sgt. Reim was able to identify the suspects responsible for the Lucas incident while also uncovering their involvement in a string of DFW metro area home invasions. His investigation netted the arrest of the two individuals responsible for this crime series while at the same time recovering a large amount of property taken during the offenses. His outstanding work resulted in lengthy prison sentences for those involved and provided closure for the victims of these traumatizing events.

On 04/23/2024 at the Collin County District Attorney's Office Crime Victim Rights luncheon, Sgt. Reim was recognized for his actions in this case receiving the Collin County District Attorney's Office Super Sleuth award for 2024.

Some say that being a good criminal investigator sometimes requires a little luck. Luck doesn't solve crime, great investigators do through hard work, keen observation, and persistence while always striving to do the right thing. Sgt. Reim's actions during the course of this investigation personify the dogged determination and willingness to go the extra mile that are required when faced with complicated cases where few leads exist.

Sgt. Reim's actions are worthy of a GEM award and employee of the month recognition.
