Jail Case Officer Jennifer Adams helped research, develop and implement an all electronic transfer of sentencing information to the Texas Department of Criminal Justice. JCO Adams worked directly with Jail Case Coordinator Courtney Lopez and other agencies to learn how their processes functioned and what problems they encountered. By taking the best ideas from each agency and learning from their mistakes, JCO Adams utilized her decades of knowledge to assist the Collin County Information Technology Department in developing a new process for review by TDCJ. During the review, JCO Adams worked directly with JCC Lopez and Collin County IT refining the process until an optimal solution for both agencies was finalized. This resulted in a product that saves over \$5,000 a year and saw a reduction in work hours of 72.7%, freeing her up to direct her efforts on other areas within her scope. JCO Adams's efforts have promoted an expeditious and cost effective approach to an outdated process. Her efforts have been tireless and gone above the performance of her scheduled duties for several weeks. Based upon her efforts to assist in public safety and the mission of the Collin County Sheriff's Office, JCO Adams is deserving of a GEM award.
