The Collin County Detention Facility currently conducts a daily, morning arraignment for inmates in custody. The facility recently conducted a second, afternoon arraignment as a two week trial period to determine if the addition of such a proceeding would be beneficial to the Detention Facility.

Officer Jeremy Gravette is a Detention Officer currently assigned to the Inmate Programs Department. During the weeks of May 7, 2018-May 18, 2018, Officer Gravette modified his work hours to be available in the Arraignment area to provide security during the afternoon proceedings. Officer Gravette went above and beyond by not only adjusting his schedule and meeting the needs of the facility in the additional capacity; he did so without compromising any of his duties in his assigned position.
