On August 21, 2018 the Collin County Sheriff's Office Admissions/Release division underwent a full conversion of the Texas Commission on Jail Standards Screening Form for Suicide and Medical/Mental/Developmental Impairments intake screening process, from the previously unfunded State mandated manual paper process, to a fully electronic Laserfiche business flow process. After his transfer to the Process Lieutenant position in November 2017, Lieutenant Christensen was assigned the task of completing a process begun by his predecessor. He spent many months in preparation for this project, meeting with I.T. personnel and working to develop the revised intake screening form and business flow process, and worked many adjusted shifts and extra hours in preparation for and supervision of the project's launch.
