Why the Honoree is receiving a GEM Award including dates:

Detention Officer Kimberly Yearwood joined the Collin County Sheriff's Office in February of 2022. Yearwood currently works with the North Texas Fusion Center to assist with booking operations, inmate photography, and identification of known or suspected gang members housed in the Collin County Detention Facility. Since her arrival in February Yearwood has identified, photographed and confirmed 107 known gang members, resulting in a fourfold increase in NTFC TXGANG validations over the previous three month period. Although she offices in the NTFC, Yearwood dedicates at least 30 hours per week providing direct help to the Booking Platoon and on Facility Movement whenever required. Yearwood is an invaluable asset to the NTFC and the Detention Facility.
