Deputy Carroll located the parents in Dallas through his field investigation and he spoke with the parents via phone. Deputy Carroll relayed this valuable information to his Sgt. and the Criminal Investigations Section. Because of Deputy Carroll's consistent thoroughness, the Criminal Investigations Section located the parents at a residence in Dallas and the child was not present nor would the parents cooperate with the criminal investigators. The information Deputy Carroll provided and the thoroughness of his fieldwork led the criminal investigators in a direction that solved a child death. Deputy Carroll was training a new recruit that day which provided valuable knowledge to help that recruit once he's out of field training. Based on the above actions of Deputy Carroll, I recommend he receive a GEM Award.
