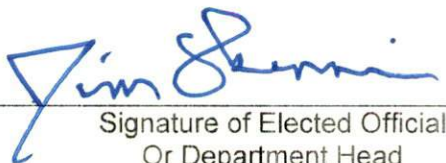

Why the Honoree is receiving a GEM Award including dates:

Deputy Carroll is assigned as a patrol deputy to B-Platoon Night shift. Deputy Carroll showed uncommon initiative by personally impacting the criminal element, in the Westminister area of operations. These acts occurred between the dates of 09/10/2018 and 10/03/2018. During this time, Deputy Carroll using community policing techniques, made multiple contacts within Westminister community. Deputy Carroll by using the information gained through these contacts, was able to identify several locations that suspects were residing and actively engaging in criminal activity. Deputy Carroll made several criminal activity information reports. Deputy Carroll acting as a valued team player took the information gained and passed it along to the entire shift and other patrol personnel. Deputy Carroll completed an entire case work-up, including photographs of the locations, criminal histories and photographs of all suspects involved, and an synopsis of the intelligence discovered. Due to the Deputy Carroll's unwavering commitment to serving and protecting the citizens of Westminister, there has been four on-view felony narcotic arrests and three on-view misdemeanor arrests conducted to date.

Deputy Carroll's actions during this time brought great credit upon himself, B-Platoon night shift, and the Collin County Sheriff's Office. Deputy Shane Carroll went above and beyond a deputy's daily expectations.
