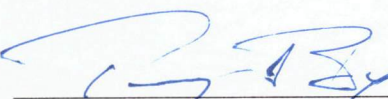

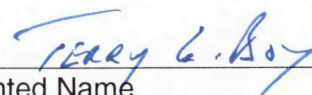
Why the Honoree is receiving a GEM Award including dates:

On 11/14/2014 Deputy Scott Stone was assigned to patrol for the Sheriff's Office. Deputy Stone was on his way to a non-emergency call that was not in progress. Dispatch gave a "BOLO" for a vehicle that was involved in Robbery just outside Collin County. The vehicle was being followed by a witness on State Highway 78 near where Deputy Stone was located. Deputy Stone chose to postpone his response to the original call and search for the robbery suspect(s) who posed a threat to the community. The vehicle was located at the Dollar Store in Blue Ridge, Tx. One of the suspects fled on foot from the vehicle but was later located in the area by the K-9 Unit from the Texas Department of Corrections. Deputy Stone responded well to the situation and his decision to forgo the non-emergency call allowed for the arrest of a felon.
