This case was just closed by the Grand Jury on February 21, 2013 or the submission

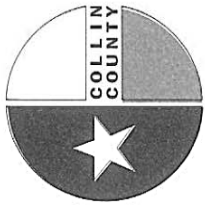
would have been made sooner. A memo from Lt. Hawkes, one of the deputies
